- ◆ Pre anesthetic medications and general anesthesia with full patient monitoring
- ◆ Ultrasonic scaling of all teeth above and below the gumline
- ◆ Digital imaging, full periodontal probing, charting and health assessment
- ◆ Digital dental radiographs of your pet's entire mouth
- ◆ Motorized polishing of all teeth after cleaning
- ◆ Hospitalization for the day for anesthetic recovery and observation

In those cases, the veterinarian will recommend the tooth or teeth be extracted. Fees for extractions can vary widely depending on the nature and condition of the tooth or teeth involved.
